Zack Nelson and wife have moved and donated a locking file cabinet to the office. We will have to get a locksmith and have a key made.

Next Tuesday, June 13, is Food Bank Day.

July 4 meeting has been cancelled. The next meeting day will be July 11th at Dorothy's.

Life memberships have been investigated and \$100. Seems to be the amount that people will pay. Different levels were not favored. There are companies that will produce life membership pins. Thomas A. will get with Tom Z. to see how the monies will be separated. It has been suggested that we have three scholarships each year. It was unanimous that the name the fund should be the "Bennie Lohman Scholarship Endowment Fund". We will present a certificate to Bennie on July 11 to that effect. Life membership will be \$50. down, and two payments of \$25. each month.

Two scholarships have been given to high school students.

Raymond Taylor, VSO, reported that he has been awarded two grants. \$30,000 for the Tobacco Fund for transportation, and \$40,000 for the mental health fund. Success of these grants is due to good collaboration between agencies and efficient paperwork.
